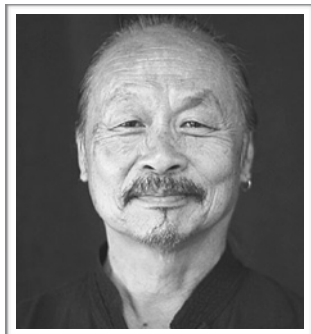

*This event is offered at no cost as a gift to the community, with presentations & workshops from international and local experts on inclusivity and diversity.*

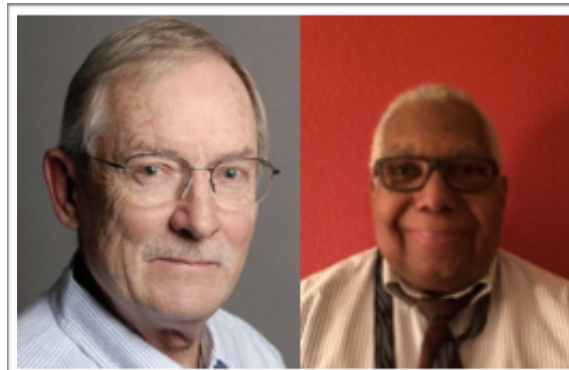
**Keynote speaker:**
