
IN THE MUD GRANTS

INTERPRETATIVE MINISTRY PLAN 2019-2020





2020 INTERPRETATIVE MINISTRY PLAN





This is our most essential work: increasing church vitality and connection. It includes search and call, crisis response, strategic planning, and helping churches with communication platforms and best practices... all to advance the mission of Christ in the Rockies!

UCC COVENANT - 24%

We're taking our mission to the world at large! This category includes support for the national UCC, our overseas and ecumenical ministry partners, sending delegates to General Synod, and seminary support.

FAITH DEVELOPMENT - 21%

The administration of our Outdoor Ministry programs and youth camps has transitioned to La Foret. This includes a salary, as well as costs associated with our youth and adult camps and retreats.

MISSION OUTREACH - 7%

In the Mud grants have helped dozens of RMC churches create and sustain innovative programs that increase community engagement and church vitality. This year, we will be further refining our grant process and tracking the impact of In the Mud grants in the community.

BUILDING EXPENSES - 4%

Our building and office resources support the work of the Conference as well as several nonprofit organizations by providing access to low cost meeting and office spaces in the downtown Denver area.
