## **Position Summary:**

Our mission is to enhance worship by providing high-quality music, create a welcoming, inclusive and growing music ministry, expose the congregation to a wide variety of music genres and experiences, all with the intention of connecting people to God. We are a progressive and inclusive, open and affirming, Ecumenical church who knows great music is central to the spirit of worship. We seek a part-time Director of Worship and Arts who is an experienced worship leader well versed in both Traditional and Contemporary musical styles. Competency and character are key ingredients for a good fit. We are looking for our musical program to thrive under a Director of Worship who is a humble leader and a team player who is able to shape a progressive and excellent musical culture.

We have a choir director and accompanist for our Traditional Worship at 8:00 am and our 10:00 am Contemporary Worship has a group of vocalists and musicians. The Director of Worship and Arts will be a champion for and bring oversight to both services. Due to current staffing coverage we see this position as mostly focused on Contemporary service direction with oversight over the Traditional service.

## This Position and Person Will:

- Possess strong interpersonal and communication skills (including conflict resolution) with the ability to maintain healthy relationships.
- Plan and organize worship service music.
- Coordinate and schedule all worship service music in conjunction with the pastor's theme/sermon of the week.
- Plan for seasonal special music for Lent, Holy Week, Advent and Christmas.
- Develop calendar and coordinate with the appropriate contacts to plan and schedule various music groups/musicians for each Sunday service.
- Collaborate with the other music leadership to choose music that reinforces our theology and creates an appropriate experience.
- Rehearse with band and other music groups. The ability to work with musical groups such as choir and contemporary band to improve skills and prepare for worship services.
- Be musically competent at a level to lead the band and corporate worship. Have good pitch, stage presence, and can lead with either guitar or piano. Can read music and create chord/lyric charts.

- Have strong administrative skills with ability to manage the music department budget, coordinate schedules, organize short and long term logistics and communicate details with others.
- Be a community builder helping to work with soloists, youth, collaborating with a church band and developing special musical groups.
- Be able to effectively recruit, and lead instrumental musicians as well as vocal musicians.
- Have interest, vision, and sufficient knowledge to collaborate with areas of CUC ministry that are supportive (e.g. technical: audio, lighting, video production, social media, etc.) or creative (e.g. visual arts, design, dance, dramatic, etc.)
