Transformed Giving – Year-Round Stewardship

"For where your treasure is, there your heart is also." -Jesus in Matthew 6:21

"As a form of ministry, fundraising is as spiritual as giving a sermon, entering a time of prayer, visiting the sick, or feeding the hungry." –Henri Nouwen, "Spirituality of Fundraising"

"No money, no mission," our council member taught me. If we are to faithfully carry out our mission as churches, we need the money to do it. The good news – our people are generous and want to make an impact for good in the world! Our task is to help them understand money, experience the joy of giving, and live lives of deep gratitude.

And, oh, to **ask for money** and to do it regularly. Then say thank you, early and often, and report back on the great work their investment is accomplishing in the world.

To do year-round stewardship, a monthly calendar is provided below. In addition to those items specific to each month, each monthly **Stewardship Team meeting** needs to be reviewing the following items:

- A. <u>Testimony/Witness/Stories of Impact</u>: Have someone at least once a month, if not weekly, get up in worship and share what they love about your church or the impact your congregation is having in the community.
- B. <u>Expressions of Gratitude</u>: How are we doing at saying thank you in as many ways as possible?
- C. <u>Social Media/Communications</u>: Are we getting our stories and thank yous out there through our newsletter, bulletin, Facebook, etc., channels?
- D. Worship:
 - 1. <u>Offering Invitation</u>: Is this clear and joyful and sharing stories of impact? Is it thanking people for all different kids of giving (time, talent, treasure, etc.)?
 - 2. <u>Preaching Stewardship Almost Weekly</u>: Jesus talked about money & possessions second only to the reign of God.
 - 3. <u>Bulletin Inserts & Covers</u>: Are we using these to effectively offering thanksgiving and stories and mission connections?
 - 4. **Children**: How are we teaching financial stewardship to our children in worship through children's messages and offerings?

In addition to the monthly calendar below, you may also want to have an Annual Stewardship Theme and Seasonal or Monthly Subthemes.

I also recognize that there's a lot here. I would expect very few committees to get all of this done each year. But that gives you something for next year! The **items in bold** are the necessary pieces to accomplish, in addition to the every month list on the previous page. I hesitate to even do that because these are the practical technical items – and they will only get you so far. A fuller approach like that outlined below will begin to instill the Culture of Generosity & Gratitude necessary in your congregation to grow giving and support.
