Mission Outreach - 0.8%

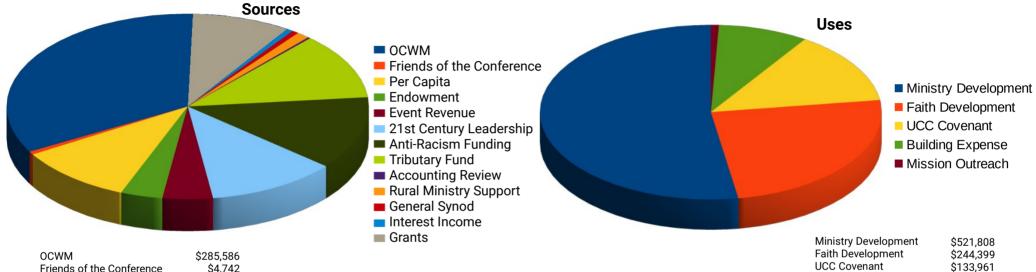
