# Becoming a UCC Church Rocky Mountain Conference UCC 2022

#### 1. Inquiry

- a. Church initiates conversation with the Formation & Authorization Subcommittee of the RMC and expresses interest in joining the UCC
- b. FAS team meets with congregational and church leaders to determine roadmap and covenanting process
- c. Local church forms a local church discernment team if it has not already done so.

### 2. Roadmap

# a. UCC Background

For churches who have an established relationship with the UCC by ministerial standing or congregational participation in wider church activities.

- i. Why UCC conversation with FAS

- iii. FAS Team presents the Marks, explains the way in which we engage them, and offers ideas for how to be in conversation about them in their church

## b. Entry from Other Denominations

For churches who are exiting their current denomination to join the UCC

- i. Why UCC conversation with FAS, why leaving current denomination, what is your exit plan?
- ii. Determine appropriate wider-church discernment team (FAS, Association, Mentor Church, others as appropriate)
- iii. FAS Team presents the Marks, explains the way in which we engage them, and offers ideas for how to be in conversation about them in their church

#### c. New Church Starts

For churches who are forming or have formed in the last 3 years and have no current denominational affiliation.

- i. Why UCC conversation with FAS
- ii. Determine appropriate wider-church discernment team (FAS, Association, Mentor Church, others as appropriate)
- iii. FAS Team presents the Marks, explains the way in which we engage them, and offers ideas for how to be in conversation about them in their church

### d. Covenantal Partners

For all churches who have denominational affiliation and who intend to affiliate with the UCC in addition to other denomination(s).

- i. Why UCC conversation with FAS, why multiple, how do the various affiliations work together?
- ii. Conversations with leadership from other denominations
- iii. Determine appropriate wider-church discernment team (FAS, Association, Mentor Church, others as appropriate)
- iv. FAS Team presents the Marks, explains the way in which we engage them, and offers ideas for how to be in conversation about them in their church

# 4. Ministerial Standing

- a. Ministers with Current UCC Standing
  - Validation of ministerial standing requirements have been met and are current.
     Any outstanding ministerial standing requirements must be met.
- b. Ministers without Any Standing
  - i. Lay ministerial standing process for a limited amount of time to allow the minister to engage in the MID process. Position of Trust completed, Anti-Racism has begun (not necessarily complete, if active in process). Psych evaluation completed and approved by FAS before lay ministerial standing is granted.
  - ii. As an alternative to membership requirement, the Minister would be asked to engage in a UCC community of practice with other ministers as they discern a sense of call so
- c. Ministers with Standing in Other Denominations
  - Transfer of standing complete.
- d. Lay Ministers
  - i. Lay ministerial standing process completed. Position of Trust completed, Anti-Racism has begun (not necessarily complete, if active in process)

# 5. Welcome & Celebration

- a. Checklist is completed
- b. Final conversation with entire discernment team (incl. Local church discernment team), all of FAS, and at least one conference minister (or ACM)
  - i. Review what has been discerned
  - ii. Share mission & vision
  - iii. Answer any outstanding questions
  - iv. Evaluate process
- c. FAS votes to grant standing

- d. Covenanting Service
- e. Introduction to Conference
- f. Presentation to Conference at Annual Celebration & General Synod
