Overview: The Faith and Justice Youth Leader is a key position to guide the programs of faith education and deepen faith for our youth.

Terms of Employment:

- This is a part-time – 8 hours per week, *Hourly (2025 - \$40/hr)*

Reporting To: Pastor

Direct Reports: None

Responsibilities:

- Present every Sunday to teach Youth
- Organizes and leads Justice-based trip once a year
- Organizes and leads quarterly social gatherings for youth and their families
- Organizes youth to lead their own mission work
- Coordinates integration of program into worship as needed
- Organizes volunteers for youth programs

Qualifications/Requirements:

- OWL trained – Able to speak to progressive theology and sexual health
- Theologically trained to meet needs of older, thoughtful youth with deeper questions
- Experience working with volunteers
- Familiarity with how a church works is a plus
- Strong team player with the rest of the staff and congregation
- Committed to the church's vision, leadership, and people
- Dependable, responsible, self-motivated and creative
- Pass criminal background check
