The Coordinator will report to the pastor but work in coordination with the Board of Faith Formation (BFF), the Minister of Music, and church volunteers. We are looking for someone to bring new energy and ideas to our programs, including:

- Creative, thoughtful, age-appropriate Church School activities for grades preK-5th
- Meaningful youth programs, including fellowship, worship, and service (including biannual mission trip) opportunities for grades 6-12.
- Adult study groups and programs
- Events to promote connections among families of the church
- Creative methods to recruit and train volunteers.
