Pre-Authorization Committee (Pre-Auth) Rocky Mountain Conference, UCC

A person senses a call to ministry

Meet with pastor of your local church

If pastor affirms sense of call, meet with Local Church Discernment Committee

If local church affirms sense of call, church requests a meeting with Pre-Auth, pre-auth-reg@rmcucc.org

- -Begin ministerial profile draft

*Initial MID Documents:

- -500-750 word statement on sense of call, faith journey
- -Letter confirming membership in local church
- -Letter of recommendation from Church Council
- -3 Letters of Reference: (a) one from the local church pastor, (b) one from a person outside of the home church, and (c) one of MID's choice (not a family member)

Use this time to complete your draft Profile, psychological testing, and fulfill your boundary training** Candidate spends a minimum of one year in discernment with clergy advisor and Local Church Discernme

Candidate is ready for authorized ministry in UCC: Ordination Pending Call

Candidate is ready to schedule an **Ecclesiastical Council** in conjunction with the COM.

Candidate is ready to move forward from discernment: Portfolio Presentation Ordination Interview with Pre-Auth
